Northern Pipeline Interconnector Stage 2

QUEENSLAND, AUSTRALIA

McConnell Dowell Constructors (Aust) Pty Ltd as part of the Northern Network Alliance (NNA), which also includes Abigroup and KBR, have been awarded the approx. \$320 million Northern Interconnector Stage 2 Project (NPI) by LinkWater, a Queensland Government owned company. The NPI – Stage 2 is a vital piece of infrastructure designed to help secure the water supply for South East Queensland, including the Sunshine Coast. The works include planning, design, construction and commissioning of approximately 48 km of underground, reverse-flow pipeline which will connect the existing Northern Pipeline Interconnector (stage 1) at Eudlo to the Noosa Water Treatment Plant at Cooroy. The works also include the construction of a balance tank, several pump stations, a water quality facility and augmentation to existing facilities. This award continues McConnell Dowell's ongoing relationship with LinkWater and the Queensland State Government which has included construction of over \$1 billion worth of works including the Southern Regional Water Pipeline, the Western Corridor Recycled Water Pipeline, the Northern Pipeline Interconnector

(Stage 1) and the Eastern Pipeline Interconnector. Construction is due to commence in November under Alliance Manager Ian Clark and Construction Manager Leon Richards. Commissioning is due in August 2011 with handover scheduled for December 2011.
